Agricultural Exemption Cards

- Oklahoma Tax Commission is requiring proof that you are attempting to **FARM** for a profit to be eligible for an Agricultural Exemption Card
 - Electronic copy of your Schedule "F" from your income taxes for renewals
 - Electric copy of a 3 Year Business plan for NEW
- To apply or renew your Agricultural Exemption Card you will need to visit the website OKTAP.TAX.OK.GOV
- You renew your Agricultural Exemption Card every three years before June 30 of that year
- Any questions regarding the application you can contact 405-522-5385
- Once your application is approved and all taxes are current you will receive your card in the mail

It is the <u>taxpayers'</u> responsibility to render all farm equipment that is used to attempt to make a profit to the Assessor's office each year

You will receive a tax bill on that equipment each year in November with your other tax bill

To assist you, we will mail an OTC 924 form at the beginning of each year (NOT A TAX BILL)

- Fill out completely both pages
- Sign and date the bottom
- Return to Assessor's office before March 15, to avoid any penalties

OTC 924 – Agricultural Personal Property

All taxable property in Oklahoma is required to be rendered to the county assessor between January 1 and March 15 of each year by the owner or person in control of such property. Property rendered after March 15 but before April 15 shall have a mandatory ten percent penalty applied. Property rendered after April 15 shall have a twenty percent penalty applied.
